This letter is an invitation to participate in the upcoming SoCal Day of HOPE community outreach. In the April 2015 SoCal Day of HOPE Outreach was launched. The event was a great success! This was a great milestone for the So Cal Day of HOPE collaborative. The outreach is a regional event done for the first time in April with a venue in Anaheim and Moreno Valley, CA. We served approximately 1000 people between the two venues and with all the food we sent to the local churches and food distribution programs we estimate that another 3000 people were reached as a result of the SoCal Day of HOPE. In addition we were able to provide free meals, health services, clothing & shoes, prayer and a kid zone at both venues. Our volunteers and agencies came from all five counties and even as far as from the Bay area. The testimonies of what this outreach did for people are numerous.
